

ECTS-granting “Monetary Theory and Policy” and “International Macroeconomics and Finance”

- students taking the lecture course "Monetary Theory and Policy" obtain 3 ECTS for passing the exam
- students taking the lecture course "International Macroeconomics and Finance" obtain 3 ECTS for passing the exam
- combining both lectures with exams yields a module of 6 ECTS.
- each of the lectures can be combined with a term paper and thus yield 6 ECTS points if the exam **AND** the term paper are passed successfully.
- thus, students can receive a maximum of 12 credit points by passing the exam of both "Monetary Theory and Policy" and "International Macroeconomics" plus writing term papers for both lectures
- those students who want to write a term paper have to register until **May, 10th**, by writing an e-mail to florian.neumeier@wiwi.uni-marburg.de or britta.niehof@wiwi.uni-marburg.de. Please write down your name, matriculation number ("Matrikelnummer") and field of study (an additional registration via LFS/QIS at the end of May is required)
- note that registration is **binding**: those students who register and do not hand in a term paper until the deadline for paper submission ends will receive 3 malus points!
- after the registration deadline ends, we will present you a list with topics for your term papers; you can name three preferred topics out of that list. We will try to match preferences as best as possible but in the case of overbooking of topics we will roll the dice!
- the topics will be assigned until the end of May
- deadline for paper submission: end of July
