Development of your own profile:

From the start, you will be able to select one of the two course specialisations that match your profile: „Social pedagogy“ or“Extracurricular education for adolescents and adults”.

Skills for independent research work and conveyance of profession-related key qualifications:

Consolidate your area of specialisation during the course of your master's programme scientifically and with respect to your occupational field by dealing with questions relating to education and training, teaching and learning, provision of advice and assistance as well as planning and organisation.

What we expect of you?

Your active cooperation in the events is as much an asset as is your ability to work independently. The interest in asking questions and doing research, critical thinking and participation in discussions as well as your willingness to read scientific texts and write your own papers are critical elements for the success of the academic studies.



Degree programme structure:

The 4 term master's programme (120 ECTS credits) consists of 6 compulsory and 3 elective subject modules. You have the option of completing a research-oriented as well as a professional field-related course of studies

Topical focuses:

- Depending on the selected major subject, you will focus extensively on theory, history, institutions, courses of action and teaching/learning arrangements in 2 modules.
- The modules „Advice, Moderation and Supervision“ as well as „Organisation and Networks“ are other key subject areas.
- In addition, you will complete one module concerning empirical research and evaluation and will be applying your knowledge in a research workshop.
- During the practice module which lasts 2 terms and includes a 6-week internship, you will learn skills relating to the theory-governed and methodical analysis of pedagogical problems, processes and solution strategies.
- One profile module comprises courses from other subjects or options to acquire key qualifications.
- You will be writing your master's thesis during the last academic study term.



Your qualification:

The purpose of the master's programme is your further academic qualification and specialisation in the field of pedagogy and educational science. After completing your master's degree, you will be eligible to pursue the paths of pedagogical practice as well as research and science.

Your job opportunities:

As graduate of the master's programme, professional opportunities are open to you at the management and organisational levels of educational institutions, in the fields of consulting, continuing education and advanced training, in research projects conducted at and outside of the university, as well as in research activities conducted by sponsors, associations, ministries, educational and social administrations.

Conferment of the doctorate:

Moreover, the master's programme prepares you for the subsequent conferment of the doctorate and a scientific career. Structured advice, information and events as well as a broad assistance network at institutional and university level are available to you for this purpose.



Excellent research and reputable support

The differentiated profile of research and teaching at our institute is characterised significantly by our long-term cooperation with practical pedagogic facilities. This will grant you access to interesting research projects and opens the door to promising internships as well as to future career opportunities.
