Our Goals

The Graduate Center for Humanities and Social Sciences offers Marburg Ph.D. candidates the opportunity to engage in interdisciplinary networking, in addition to providing them with help and support during their doctoral studies. The program's goals include:

- ▶ The promotion of academic exchanges in interdisciplinary research groups having common goals.
- ▶ Improving interdisciplinary dialogue among the various academic disciplines in the Humanities and Social Sciences.
- ▶ The establishment and maintenance of ties with the existing graduate colleges and doctoral colloquia at the Marburg University, as well as other national and international institutions.
