

How to get there

From Frankfurt International Airport (FRA)

Since Marburg is not far from the airport in Frankfurt Main, it is easy to travel to Marburg from international destinations by plane and train.

After proceeding through customs follow the signs to the airport's regional railway station ("Regionalbahnhof"), which is immediately below the arrival level. There you will find a Travel center with German railway ticket counters as well as ticket vending machines (with the label "RMV"). Buy a ticket to Marburg/Lahn. A one way ticket for regional trains ("RE" or "RB" trains) would be approx. 15,00 Euro. You cannot buy tickets in the trains, and the fine for fare dodging is rather high!

Fast trains ("IC" trains) will be more expensive. These tickets are sold in separate ticket vending machines (red color, with the label "DB/Bahn"). If you need any support you can go to the Travel center or ask any DB (Deutsche Bahn) staff member, they usually speak English and can help you.

Every 10-15 minutes there are trains leaving to Frankfurt main station (German: "Hauptbahnhof", abbreviation: "Hbf") from track 1. An indicating board will show the departure time of the next trains. There are two stops in-between, main station is the third stop. It will take about 10 minutes. Most of the trains will arrive at the subway station and you have to use the elevator or escalator to get to the tracks where the trains to Marburg will depart.

(There is also another option to use fast trains from the airport's long-distance railway station ("Fernbahnhof") directly to Frankfurt main station. From Terminal B it is in 5 minutes walking distance. There you will find the tracks 4-7. Detailed information about the trains is available on the track. You have to get off the next station Frankfurt "Hauptbahnhof". These trains are more expensive.)

From Frankfurt main station ("Hauptbahnhof", abbreviation: "Hbf") approx. every 30 minutes a train is leaving to Marburg. Depending on the train connection, 60-90 minutes later you will arrive there. The RMV-tickets for regional trains ("RE" or "RB" trains) are not valid in fast trains ("IC" trains).

The website www.bahn.de shows all train connections. On top select an English menu instead of "Deutsch". In the field "from station" enter "Frankfurt(Main)Flugh" and in the field "to station" enter "Marburg(Lahn)".

In Marburg

All conference venues are located in the city center of Marburg within walking distance. From Marburg main railway station ("Hauptbahnhof" or "Hbf") you easily reach the city center.

There are two options. You can take a taxi in front of the station and ask the driver to bring you to the main administrative building of the University in Biegenstrasse 10/12.

Or you can take one of the many public busses that run regularly from the station to the city center (lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7). If you are leaving the station, take only the busses from the left side of the bus station – only these are going to the center. The place is marked with a red circle on the map. When you get off at the fourth bus stop "Erwin-Piscator-Haus" you are right in front of the auditorium building ("Hörsaalgebäude", = "Audimax" on the map). This is the main conference venue where all plenary sessions and workshops take place.



How to Get Here by Car

From Kassel (north):

Leave the urban motorway at the Marburg-Bahnhofstrasse exit. Take a left at the first traffic light onto Bahnhofstrasse in the direction of the city center. Change to the left lane after the next traffic light and turn left onto Elisabethstrasse at the end of Bahnhofstrasse. Stay in the left lane until you reach the next traffic light at Elisabeth Church (Elisabethkirche) and then turn left onto Deutschhausstrasse. Now go straight on at the next traffic light and follow the right bend onto Biegenstrasse. After about 300m you will see a church to your right and right next to it an entry to the parking lot.

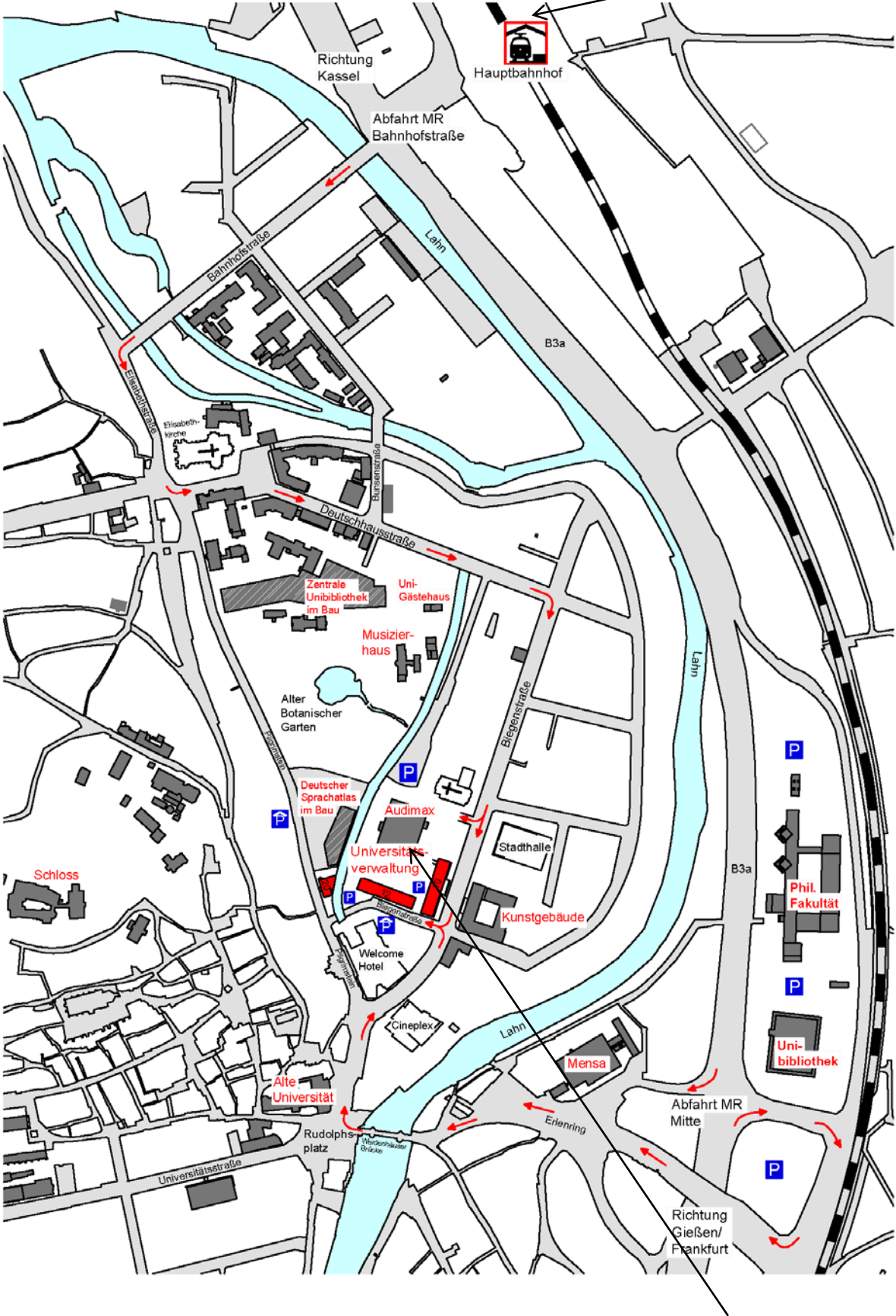
Alternatively, take the urban motorway to the Marburg-Mitte exit, turn right at the first traffic light and stay in the right lane in the direction of the city center. After two pedestrian crossings you will cross the Lahn river, then take a right turn at the next traffic light and change to the left lane. Stay in this lane and drive past the Cineplex cinema on your right. Before you reach the second traffic light, change to the left lane and turn left. You have reached the main administrative building.

From Frankfurt/Gießen (south):

Leave the urban motorway at the Marburg-Mitte exit (near the Esso petrol station) and stay in the right lane until you reach the next traffic light, then take a right turn in the direction of the city center. Now continue on in the right lane. At the third traffic light, and after crossing the bridge over the Lahn river, take a right at the next traffic light and stay in the left lane. Go past the Cineplex cinema on your right, and then change to the left lane before you reach the second pedestrian crossing, then take a left turn. You have reached the main administrative building.
