Applying for Exchange

How to Apply for Erasmus+ and Faculty Cooperations Exchange

Register and Apply via the web portal Mobility Online.
You need to...

- ✓ Register in Mobility Online
- ✓ Fill out the application form
- ✓ Upload all required documents

Deadline for submission is the **December 15!**

Required Application Documents

1. Signed Mobility Online Application Form
2. Motivation Letter for each university (one document, max. 1-2 pages in English)
3. Curriculum Vitae
4. General study plan (Which courses do you plan to attend abroad?)
5. Current Transcript of Records reporting the **average grade and sum of ECTS** achieved
6. Abitur/Highschool Diploma for Bachelor students/ or Bachelor Degree Certificate for Master students
7. Current enrolment certificate from MARVIN
8. Language proficiency certificates (min. B2 according to CEFR in the respective teaching language; DAAD Language Certificate or other)

Why Erasmus+

Erasmus+

promotes up to 12 months per study cycle (Bachelor/ Master/ PhD) of...

- ...**Studying abroad** (one or two semester)
- ...**Practical Placement** (self-organized , min. 2 months and full-time) at organizations/ companies in Europe
- ...**Combination** of studying abroad and Practical Placement

Advantages of Erasmus+:

- Mobility Grant
 - Study: 330€ - 450€ + exemption from study fees at the host university
 - Placement: EU 435 € -555 €/ Worldwide 700€ + additional
- Language courses, support and advisory services
- Recognition and transfer of credits/ internship

Requirements:

- Learning Agreement (30 ECTS per semester)
- Proven Language Skills in the teaching language
- Study-related stay (3-12 months per cycle)
- Bachelor students: Completion of first year of studies
