If it's your first time here, don't worry! following this guide will help you travel stress-free.

To get to Marburg, we need our tickets.
Let's get them!

STEP 1

- After collecting your luggage, leave the airport and go to Terminal 1.
- Look for the sign "Bahnhöfe S-Bahn" and follow it.
- These signs will guide you to the train area and ticket machines.



The "Bahnhöfe ST"
looks like this:





STEP 2



- On the way, you will see the ticket machines.



- At the bottom of the screen, you can change the language.





- Select "Place name" and type your destination: Marburg Hauptbahnhof (If it doesn't appear, use "Marburg City")



Choose "one-way ticket"
(Approximate price: 19€)

You can pay in cash or by card.





! **Important:** Keep your ticket until the end of your journey.

Ticket inspectors may check it – if you don't have one, you may receive a €60 fine.

STEP 3

- Go to the correct platform 🚪
Platform 1 / Gleis 1: Frankfurt City
- Take an S-Bahn (suburban train)

You can choose:

- **S8** → direction Offenbach (Main) – Offenbach Ost.
- **S9** → direction Hanau Hauptbahnhof

The S-Bahn looks like this:




STEP 4

Here you need to change trains at Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof 



Stop: Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof / Frankfurt am Main (Central Station)

Check the information boards to find:
Your train, The correct platform and departure time.

- Then take a regional train (**RE98** or **RE30**) toward Kassel.



RE98/ RE30

📍 **IMPORTANT:** If you take this train (**RE98**), please note that it splits into two sections: one going to Marburg and the other to a different destination.

Make sure you are on the car that continues to Kassel (stopping at Marburg Lahn).



You can also take the RB41 train, which has its last stop in Marburg.
