

How can I buy the tickets from Frankfurt airport to Marburg Train Station?

When you arrive at the airport and you already have your baggage with you, you have to go to **TERMINAL 1**. Once you are there, please follow this sign: "Bahnhöfe ST"



In your way you will see this "Automat" where you can buy your ticket.

The screen looks like this and in the bottom part you can change the language.



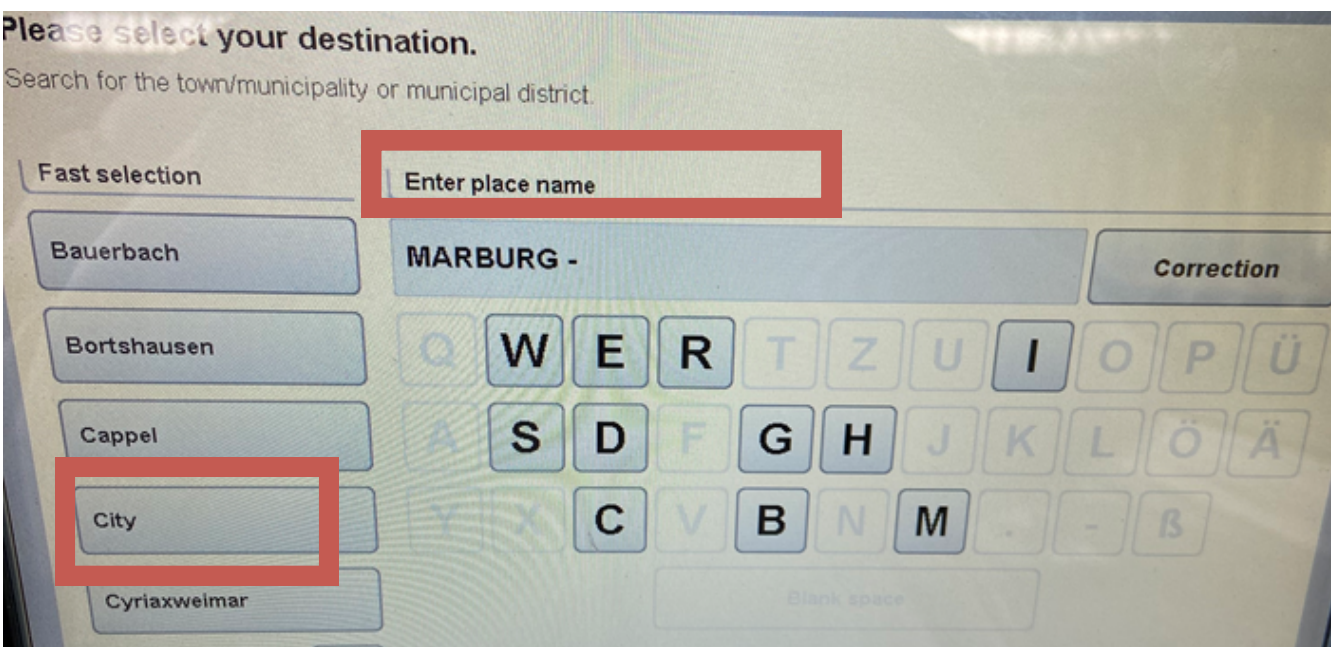

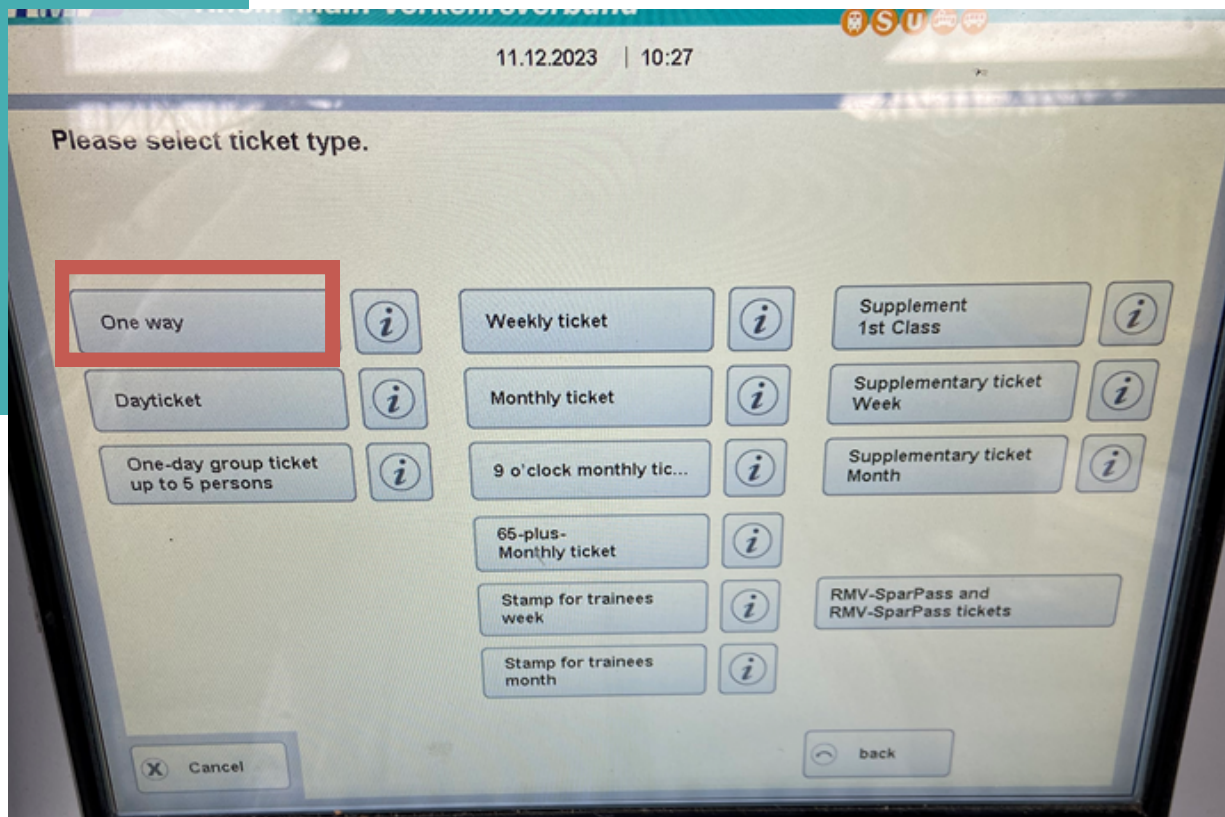
You have to choose: "Place name"

And write your destination
To: Marburg Hauptbahnhof



If you do not find "Marburg Hauptbahnhof" you can select "Marburg City"

Then select “one way” ticket

The price for the ticket is usually:
19,60 euros

You can pay with cash or card.

Once you have your ticket you have to go to the platform 1
“ Frankfurt City”

You will take a suburban railway called “S-Bahn”

You can take the S8 direction:
Offenbach (Main)-Offenbach Ost
Ostbahnhof

or

S9 with direction to Hanau
Hauptbahnhof



The “S-Bahn”
looks like this

You have to change trains.
For this reason, you will get off at
Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof (Frankfurt
Main Central Station).



Now you need to take a train. Please check
the display boards to see which train
matches your time of arrival.

Now you need to take a train — either the **RE98**
or the **RE30** in the direction of Kassel. They look
like this:



If you take this train (**RE98**), please
be aware that it splits into two
sections — one going to Marburg and
the other to a different destination.
Make sure you are in the carriage
that continues toward Kassel (it
stops in Marburg).

You can also take the **RB41**, which
has its final stop in Marburg.

Advices

The trains depart from platforms 15 or 16, but please check the display boards, as this may change.

The journey with the RE30 or RE98 takes about 1 hour, while the RB41 takes around 1 hour and 50 minutes.

You cannot buy the tickets in advance. You must purchase them on the same day.
