Yuderkys Espinosa Miñoso is a candidate for a PhD in philosophy from the University of Buenos Aires. Afro-Caribbean anti-racist and decolonial theorist, teacher, researcher and popular educator. One of the forerunners and main exponents of anti-racist and decolonial feminism in Latin America and the Caribbean. Her main contributions advance towards a criticism of the coloniality of feminist reason. Independent professor and researcher, she is a frequent guest of universities, organizations and social movements in Latin America, the USA and Europe.



She is founding member of the Grupo Latinoamericano de Estudios, Formación y Acción Feminista (GLEFAS) and Junta de Prietas. Recent publications: "Decolonial Feminism: New theoretical-methodological contributions more than a decade on" (Editorial Abya Yala, 2019); "Decolonial Feminism in Abya Yala: Caribbean, Meso, and South American. Contributions and Challenges", co-edited with María Lugones and Nelson Maldonado-Torres (Rowman and Littlefield, forthcoming 2022).
