The Princely House of Waldeck and Pyrmont Foundation provides research grants for research into its Court Library and Waldeckian history. Funding is provided exclusively to advance Waldeck related studies:

- BA/MA theses
- Doctoral theses
- Post-Docs and experienced researchers

Criteria

A) Endowment

Scholarships are tiered based on qualifications and/or a paper's academic level:

•	BA/MA theses	max. 1,000 Euro
•	Dissertations	max. 2,000 Euro
•	Post-Docs and experienced researchers	max. 2,000 Euro

B) Application and selection

Applications may be submitted informally at any time (with a project and publication outline) to:

The selection will be made by an expert committee of the foundation and based upon a submitted copy or ready-to-print manuscript of a completed academic paper.

C) Award modalities

The main decision-making criteria for the award are the academic significance and quality of the project. The award is to be made subsequent to academic paper submission, and may include an expert opinion (grade), when applicable.

The following minimum standards apply to the award:

- BA/MA theses
- Dissertations
- Post-Docs and experienced researchers

depends on grading system at least graded ,cum laude' after quality evaluation

D) Usage

The funds are available to be freely used (i.e. for printing subsidies, materials, travels, etc.).

E) Research results

After completion of the qualification and/or academic paper, the Court Library shall receive both a bound copy and an electronic version. The research results may be used by the Princely House of Waldeck and Pyrmont Foundation for <u>non-commercial</u> research use only, for example on the Court library's internet portal or its website with appropriate accreditation to the author.
