Lindita Tahiri teaches at the Department of English Language and Literature, the Department of Journalism, and the program for Translation and Interpretation at the Faculty of Philology of the University of Prishtina, Kosovo.

She has publications in the field of stylistics, critical linguistics, literary criticism, and discourse analysis, including three books. She has translated Joseph Conrad's *Heart of Darkness* into Albanian, as well as other American and English authors such as Arthur Miller, Woolf, Hemingway, Golding, Dickinson, LeGuin etc. She has also assisted in the preparation of the Oxford Albanian-English dictionary by Leonard Newmark.
