## PROCEDURES

### Nomination procedure:

Selected students must be nominated by their mobility manager by email to:

Once students have been officially nominated by their home university, they are required to complete an **online application form** which will be sent to them by email shortly after their nomination has been accepted.

### English

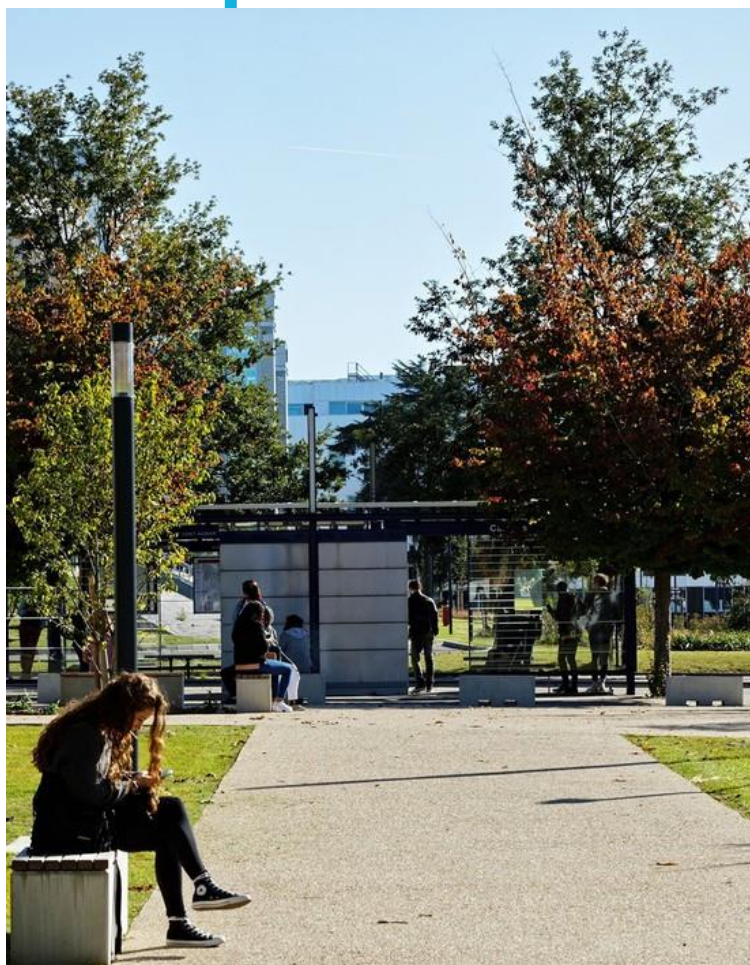
In some specific fields of study, some courses might be taught in English.

## HOUSING

### Accommodation

Exchange students can apply for a student accommodation through our partners at Studapart : [studapart.com](http://studapart.com)

Please note that the Université de Rouen Normandie does not possess any student accommodation, nor do we have a say in whether students are accepted or not when applying for an accommodation.

### Cost of rent

The cost of rent might range from 250€ to 450€ per month, depending on the type of accommodation.

We draw your attention to the fact that the housing costs can change with time. **The attribution of a home is not automatic and the places are limited.**

### VISA requirements

Non E.U. students will need a VISA **and/or** a residence permit. Please contact your local French Embassy for more information about VISA requirements.

### Health insurance

E.U. students in possession of a **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** will not require to register to the French Health Insurance system. E.U. students who do not have an EHIC will, as non E.U. students, require to register with the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM) upon their registration at the University.

### Campus facilities

Our campuses are equipped with a wireless internet connection, student restaurants and cafeterias, student libraries and a sports center.
