With over 32,000 students and 38 research units, the University of Rouen Normandy (URN) plays a leading role in both teaching and research in Normandy. We are involved in regional teaching and research clusters, and promote interregional research activities by developing nationally and internationally renowned scientific partnerships. We therefore partake in numerous international projects in partnership with over 50 countries.

As a **multidisciplinary** institution, URN is particularly devoted to making higher education accessible to all and fostering local economic and social development.

We have **7 campuses** in Normandy, with a total of **12** faculties, institutes and schools.

Nomination procedure:

Selected students must be nominated by their mobility manager by email to:

mobilite.in@univ-rouen.fr

Application procedure:

Once students have been officially nominated by their home university, they are required to complete an online **application form** which will be sent to them by email shortly after their nomination has been accepted.

HOUSING

Accomodation

Exchange students can apply for a student accomodation through our partners at Studapart: studapart.com

Please note that the Université de Rouen Normandie does not possess any student accomodation, nor do we have a say in wether students are accepted or not when applying for an accomodation.

Cost of rent

The cost of rent might range from 250€ to 450€ per month, depending on the type of accompodation.

We draw your attention to the fact that the housing costs can change with time. **The attribution of a home is not automatic and the places are limited**.

VISA requirements

Non E.U. students will need a VISA **and/or** a residence permit. Please contact your local French Embassy for more information about VISA requirements.

Health insurance

<u>E.U. students</u> in possession of a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) will not require to register to the French Health Insurance system. E.U. students who do not have an EHIC will, as <u>non E.U. students</u>, require to register with the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM) upon their registration at the University.

Our campuses are equipped with a wireless internet connection, student restaurants and cafeterias, student libraries and a sports center.
