- ✓ Establishing a collection of samples of medicinal plants and natural ingredients applied in traditional medicine of the countries in Central Asia as a scientific treasury for research and study at Marburg University.
- ✓ Resource management of medicinal and aromatic plants used in traditional medicine.

FACTS

- ✓ Less than half of the people in the world have access to essential health services (WB, WEF).
- ✓ Between 60–80% of the population in developing countries rely on traditional medicine for their basic health care needs (WHO).
- ✓ Over 40% of countries have fewer than 10 medical doctors per 10,000 people (WEF).
- ✓ Safety, efficacy, and quality are the major challenges of traditional medicine worldwide.
- ✓ Interest in traditional and complementary medicine is expanding beyond products to focus on practices and practitioners.
