As the provider, please check whether the material is subject to restrictions under foreign trade law, i.e. whether it belongs, for example, to the so-called dual-use goods that can be used for both civilian and military purposes (e.g. chemicals, biological substances and GvOs, computers with special specifications, sensors and lasers, etc..). Goods subject to licensing can be found in Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2021/821 ("EU Dual-Use Regulation") and Part I of the Export List of the Foreign Trade and Payments Regulation (Annex to the AWV).

Example biomaterials and GMOs: Annex I of the Dual-Use Regulation, Part III, Category 1 C Materials and substances is to be checked here. Human and animal pathogens and toxins are listed under 1C351. Genetic elements or GMOs are included under 1C353, and plant pathogens are additionally included under 1C354.
