- Two summer schools: Comparative Conflict Studies (June) & Sexualities, Cultures and Politics (August)

Summer School for Comparative Conflict Studies at FMK

- Every June, around 80 participants, in English
- Topics:
 - comparative politics in general, especially regarding conflict, peace, and post-conflict aftermath (reconciliation)
 - international intervention
 - peace education
 - memory studies
 - migration studies (the Balkan route)

Summer School for Sexualities, Cultures and Politics at FMK

- Every August, in English
- Topics:
 - Feminist, gender & queer studies & subjectivity
 - Experimental writing
 - Post-humanism
 - Representations of the body

International Cooperation at FMK

- Two Erasmus+ programmes: UNU-GEST at the University of Iceland in Reykyavik & Philipps-Universität Marburg
- Other partnerships: University of Vienna, Sigmund Freud University Vienna, University of West London, Marbella International University Centre (Spain)
