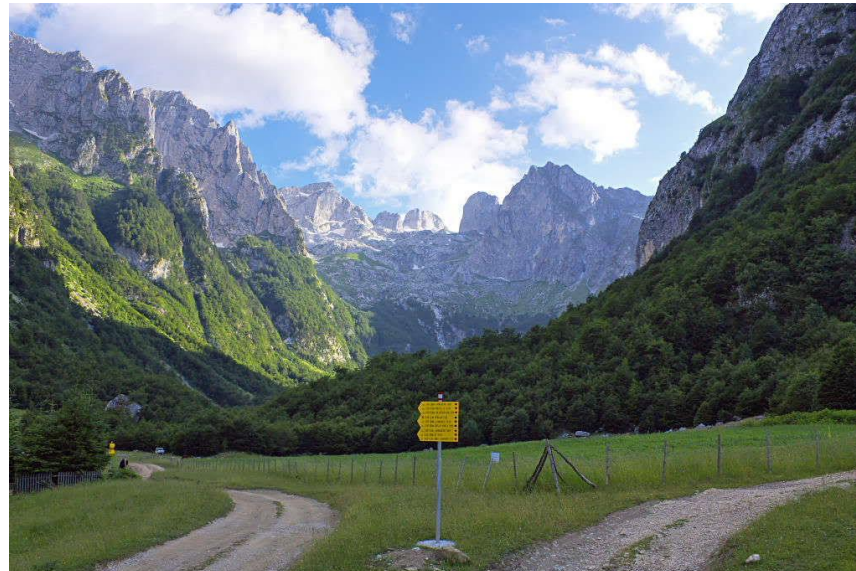
# Some Facts on Montenegro



- **Location: Southeast Europe**
- **Independent since: - 1918 and 2006 -**
- **Population: 620.000**
- **Seafarers population: over 6000 (1% of population)**
- **Area: 13.820 km<sup>2</sup>**
- **Coastline length: 300 km**
- **Highest peak at 2,534 m**
- **Largest lake: Skadar Lake — 391 km<sup>2</sup>**
- **Deepest canyon: Tara River Canyon — 1,300 m**
- **Biggest bay: Boka Kotorska**

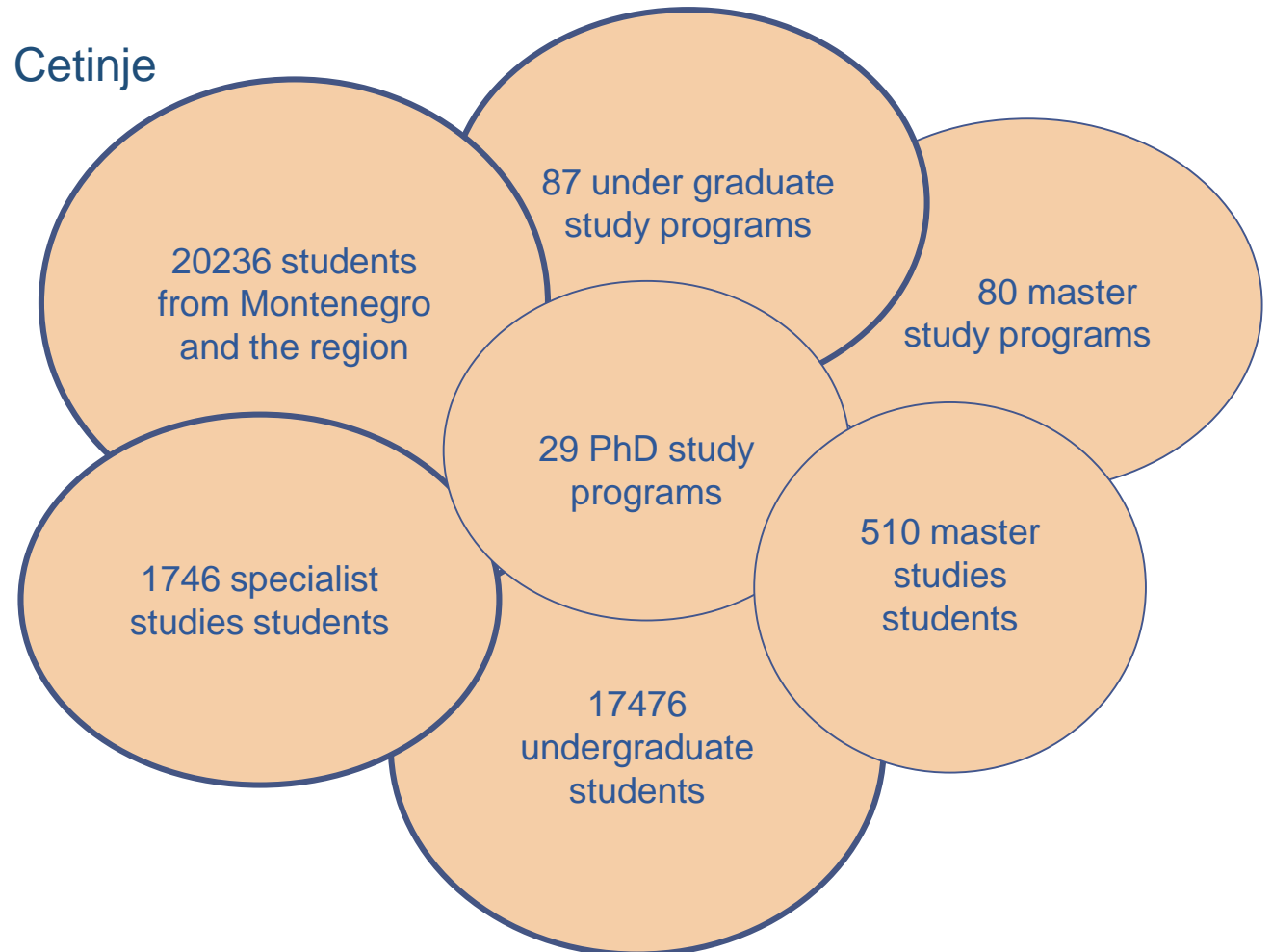

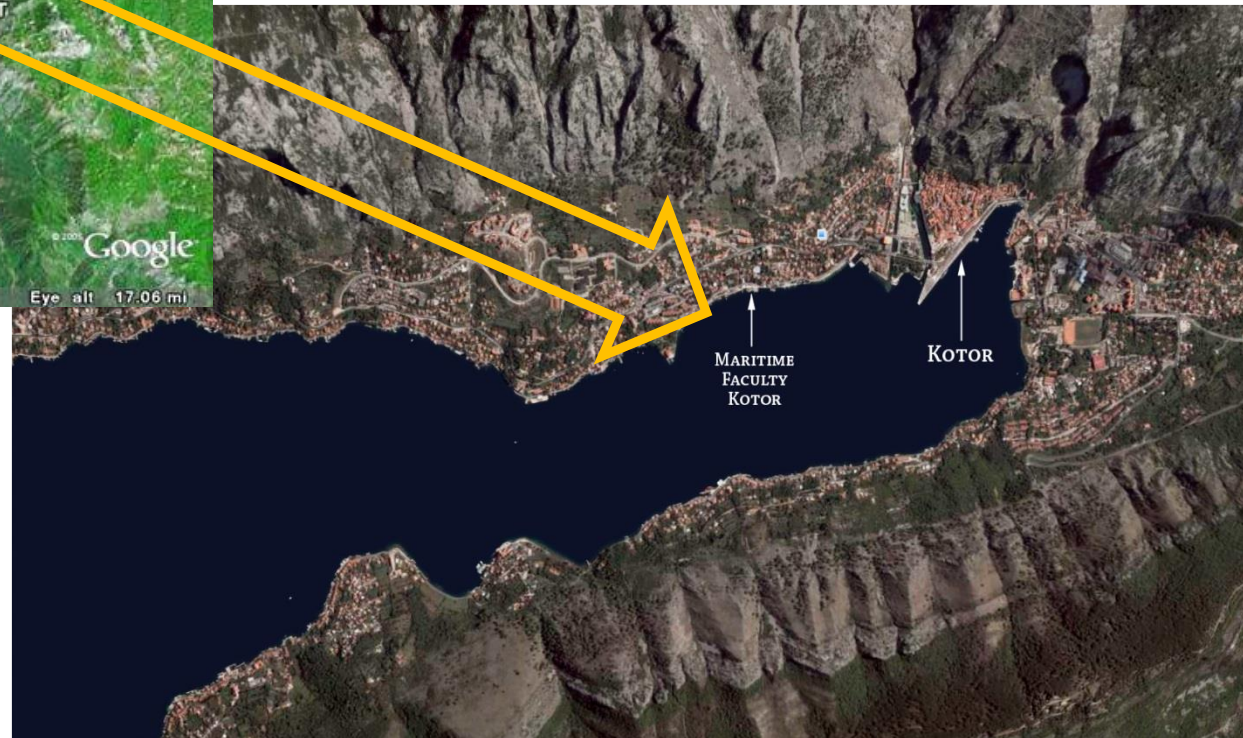

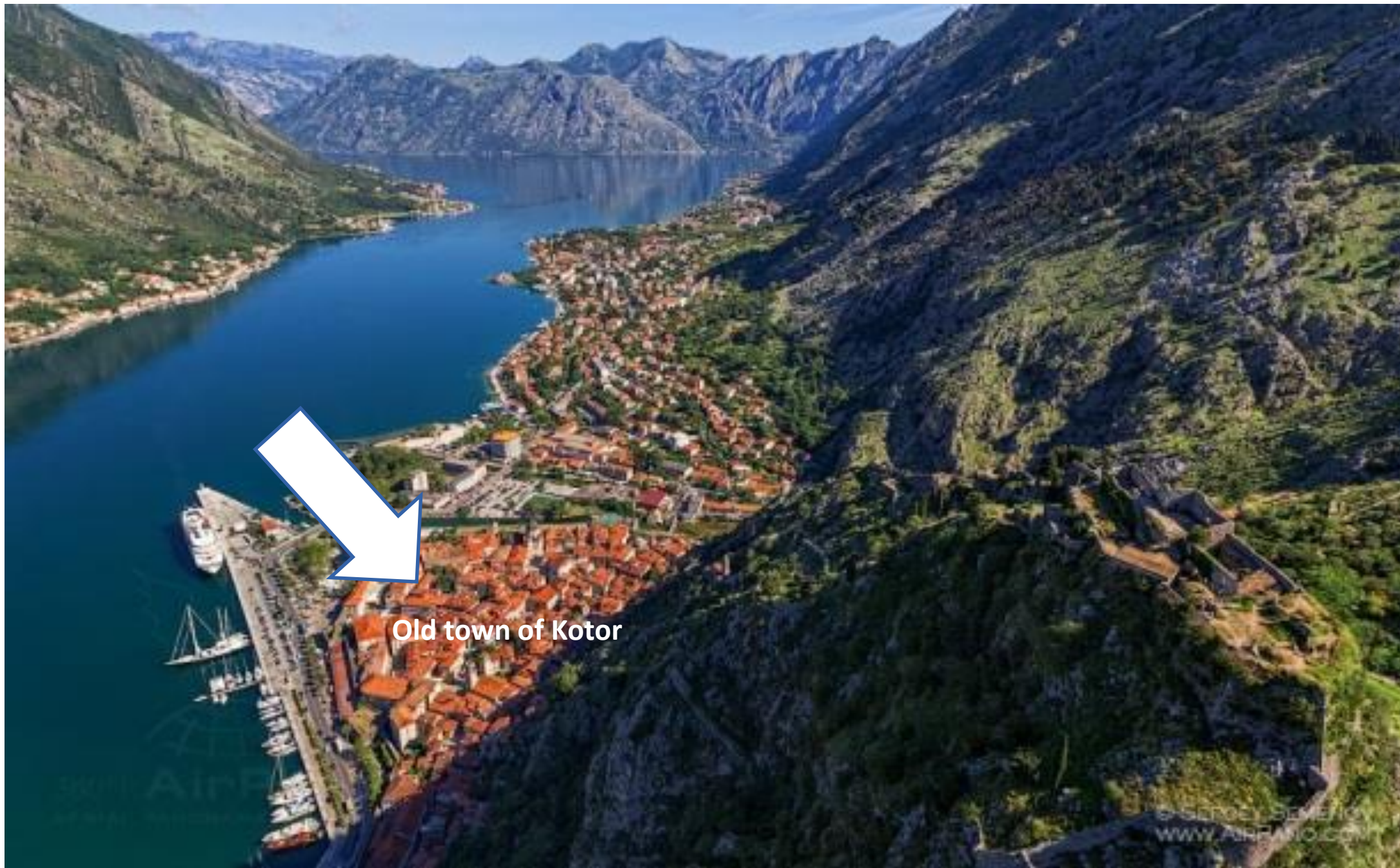




# Maritime Faculty Kotor - Location

# History of maritime education in Montenegro

- ❑ There is a material evidence of archaeological importance and archive documents testifying a 9 century old maritime tradition in the Bay of Boka Kotorska southwest part of Montenegro.
- ❑ First "schools" for seamen were established in small old towns situated in the Bay of Boka Kotorska, between 16th and the middle of 19th century. The best known of all was the one conducted by Captain Marko Martinović in the years 1697 and 1698, attended by the cadets of Russian emperor, Peter the Great.
- ❑ In 1849, Nautical School was established in Kotor, being the first public nautical education institution offering the following courses: Mathematics, Astronomy, Ship Maneuvering, Basic Principles of Shipbuilding, Geography, Commercial Correspondence and Ship Accounting.
- ❑ Maritime Faculty in Kotor, as a part of University of Montenegro, continues the tradition of education and training of seafarers in Montenegro.
- ❑ More than 6000 seafarers today in MNE



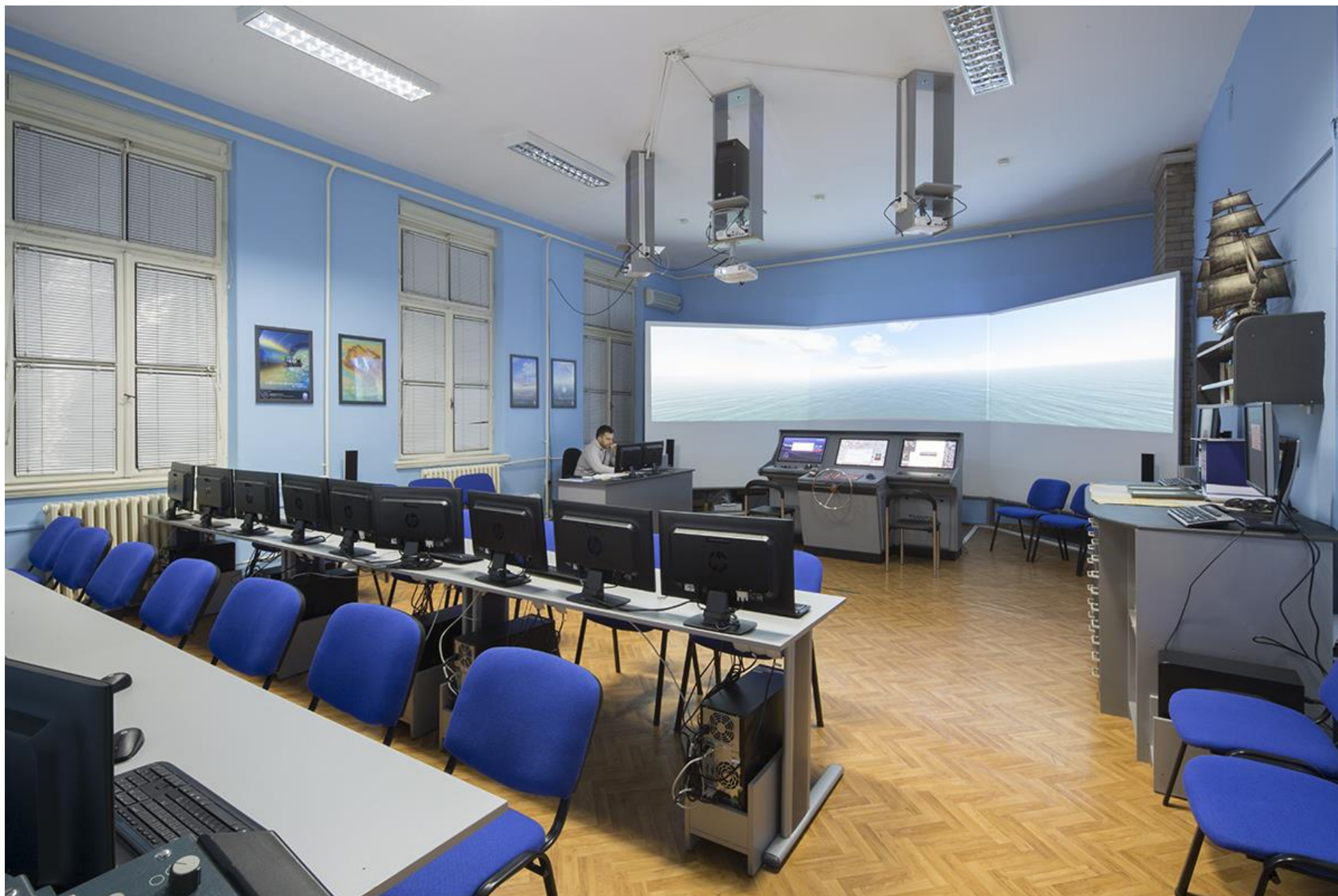
