ABOUT THE EVENT

The EUPEACE Entrepreneurship & Innovation Week is a 5-day immersive programme designed to raise awareness of entrepreneurship among students and staff from the nine EUPEACE partner universities. Organised by PEPITE (the student entrepreneurship hub) and the International Office of the University of Limoges, this event takes place from 1 to 5 June 2025 in Limoges and at the Domaine de Reynou.

The centrepiece of the week is the 24-hour Entrepreneurship Night: teams of students from different universities work together to develop an innovative project in response to a challenge linked to EUPEACE's core themes — social innovation, peace & resilience, and sustainable development. Supported by mentors and coaches throughout the night, teams then pitch their projects to a jury composed of academics, EUPEACE representatives, and professionals on the morning of Day 3.

Beyond the challenge itself, the programme includes cultural visits in Limoges, team-building activities at Reynou, a thematic masterclass, and optional visits to university research platforms. The event is open to bachelor, master, and PhD students as well as staff, with a maximum of 25 participants.

Getting there:



Limoges Airport has daily flights from/to

- Lyon Saint-Exupéry Airport (Chalair)
- Paris Orly (Volotea – 2 flights daily)
- Marseille (Volotea – 2 flights weekly)
- London Stansted (Ryanair)
- London Gatwick Airport (EasyJet – 4 flights weekly)
- Barcelone (BCN) (Volotea – 2 flights weekly)
- Rome (CIA) (Volotea – 2 flights weekly)





Limoges can be reached from


- [Paris Charles de Gaulle or Orly airports](#) and by train via **Paris Austerlitz train station**

⌚ At least 2-hour connection from Paris airports to Paris Austerlitz train station. *If your connection time is tight, a taxi could be a good option, depending on traffic conditions.*

➔ Using public transportation from Paris Charles De Gaulle Airport to Austerlitz Train Station:

1.  from the station “Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 1 or 2” to the station “Saint-Michel Notre Dame” and,
2.  Subway from the station “Saint-Michel Notre Dame / Cluny Sorbonne” to the station “Gare d’Austerlitz”



➔ Using public transportation From Paris Orly Airport – Paris Austerlitz Train Station:

1.  Subway from Paris Orly Airport to Gare de Lyon
2. 10-minutes walk to Gare d’Austerlitz

VENUE

The programme takes place across two main venues. The welcome dinner and departure day activities are held in Limoges city centre. Days 1, 2, and 3 (morning) take place at the Domaine de Reynou (Le Vigen, 87110), a magnificent estate and wildlife park located approximately 10 km south of Limoges.

We will bring the participants to the Zoo by bus, times of the pick-up will be communicated later. The pitch session on Day 3 also takes place at Reynou before the group returns to Limoges in the afternoon with a stop at Pôle de Lanaud. The afternoon of June 4th is free in Limoges.

HOUSING

Nights for participants will be covered at Zoo du Reynou from June 2nd to June 4th (2 nights)

MEALS

All meals are included in the programme for Monday night to Thursday night (dinner on 1 June through dinner on 4 June). Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be served at the Zoo du Reynou.

Dietary requirements (vegetarian, vegan, allergies) should be indicated at registration. On Friday 5, meals are at participants' own expense. Snacks and drinks will be available throughout the Entrepreneurship Night.

EVENTS

The 24-hour Entrepreneurship Night is the core of this programme. Teams are formed on Day 1 at 16:00 and work continuously — with mentoring support, methodology workshops, and coaching available throughout — until the official end of the challenge on Day 2 at 16:00. Projects are submitted digitally. Teams then present a 5-minute pitch to the jury on Day 3 at 10:00. The best projects may receive follow-up support from PEPITE for further development after the event.

PRACTICAL TIPS

Early June in Limoges is typically mild and pleasant, with average daytime temperatures between 18°C and 24°C. Light layers are recommended, especially for evenings at Reynou where it can be cooler. Comfortable walking shoes are advised for the city tour and the animal keeper activity. The Entrepreneurship Night takes place indoors — feel free to bring anything that helps you stay productive and comfortable through the night (headphones, a light blanket, snacks). Limoges is known for its porcelain heritage — a wonderful souvenir to bring home!
