We are seeking highly motivated students (Master and Ph.D.) from above mentioned four universities in the fields of economics, sociology and other closely related disciplines to join us in the upcoming winter in Mashhad.

The Winter School is a one-week academic and cultural programme, which is supported by German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) within the “Higher Education Dialogue with the Muslim World” programme. The Winter School will provide a great opportunity to expand knowledge on the political economy of natural resource management and to discuss with experts from Germany and Iran.

Selected participants from Philipps-Universität Marburg will receive a flat-rate travel allowance for economy airline tickets and accommodation according to the DAAD guidelines.

Applicants must submit the following documents in English to Mr. Sven Fischer (narem@uni-marburg.de, subject line: Application for Mashhad Winter School 2018):

- A motivation letter (max. two pages) in English, which includes the reasons why you would like to participate.
- A CV in English (including transcript of records, skills, and main achievements).
- Contact details of two academic references.
- Evidence of proficiency in English language (strongly recommended, but not compulsory).
- PhD students: A short abstract (max. one page) of ongoing research.
