Evaluationsbericht zur Lehrveranstaltungsevaluation im SoSe 16

Sehr geehrter Herr Prof. Dr. Vollan,

der vorliegende Bericht enthält die Ergebnisse der Evaluation der Lehrveranstaltung "VL: Behavioral Development Economics", die im SoSe 16 an der Universität Marburg durchgeführt wurde. Erfasst wurden 23 ausgefüllte Fragebögen vom Typ FEVOR\_EN.

Der Bericht gliedert sich in vier Teile: (1) Globalwerte, (2) Auswertung der geschlossenen Fragen, (3) Auswertung der offenen Fragen und (4) Profillininenvergleich.

(1) Globalwerte Im Abschnitt Globalwerte werden Mittelwerte (mw) und Standardabweichungen (s) der Fragengruppen Planung und Darstellung, Umgang mit den Studierenden, Interessantheit und Relevanz und Schwierigkeit, Umfang, Tempo dargestellt. (2) Auswertung der geschlossenen Fragen Im zweiten Teil der Berichts werden Verteilung, Anzahl der Antworten (n), Mittelwert (mw), Standardabweichung (s) und, sofern vorhanden, die Enthaltungen (E) für alle Scalenfragen aufgelistet, deren bester erreichbarer Wert in den meisten Fällen die 5 ist.

Ausnahmen bilden die Fragen aus dem Bereich "Schwierigkeit, Stoffumfang und Tempo", bei denen der mittlere Wert 3 der Antwortoption "genau richtig" zugeordnet ist. Die Ergebnisse von single- und multiple-choice-Fragen werden als Balkendiagramm dargestellt.



However the subject was very interesting, providing interesting insides into the Behavioural aspect of Economics, understanding the psychological dimensions into our decision making brings a whole new perspective to understanding why the state oft things in most parts of the world are the way they are.

- It's one of the most interesting courses offered in the Programme. I really enjoy the idea of the blog post.
- Overall a very good course. You presented all topics in a very good manner and I also liked your illustrations of several topics. For the future I would prefer a list of topics for the blog-post and also the essay.

- The range scope of the course is too large. Too many slids.
- The topic is clearly interested and made me aware of different economic, social and political situations out of Europe.
- Too much information on the slides, too many slides. Interesting case studies / studies but maybe better to just explain and further discuss in class -> in general, more time for discussions. Many people from different countries, interesting to discuss some of these topics in more detail. Blog was interesting to do, however blog & essay a bit too much work; if it was only the blog one might have been more likely to put more effort in it.
