I could'nt relate to them at all or the connection did not become clear. it would be great if there were more examples for funding reasons (e.g. which policy measures are suggested by a study) or if the practical motivation for research was explained more often

I would have preferred to get some feedback on the assignments, especially in the beginning when I was not yet sure about the topic and whether I am going in the right direction.

The first assignments where too much time consuming.

I think it would be better to offer this as a small seminar where it is possible to give personal feedback.
