Course and Exam Registration

Exchange students register for courses, add or drop courses and register for examinations of the **Faculty of Business and Economics** only via the

➤ [Ilias Group for Incoming Exchange Students](#).

Steps during the Semester:

1. **Course Registration via ILIAS** (Business and Economics courses only) until 1 week before start of the lecture period.
2. **„Belegliste“ in Mobility Online**
Add courses to your „Belegliste“ & confirm the list.
3. **Add/Drop Changes** are only possible within 2 weeks after start of the lecture period.
4. **Exam registration via ILIAS** within the registration deadlines.

IMPORTANT

Teaching will be held online in the summer term 2021. Examinations will require your physical attendance.

Admission to Master-Level Courses

Bachelor students are only admitted to master level courses if they have already completed 60 ECTS in Business/ Economics + Methods.

- Complete the course registration form in ILIAS or send your request with a recent transcript of records to ausland@wiwi.

Admission for Exchange students from other faculties

- Students without any prior business or economics credits, are admitted only to the *Introduction to Economics/ Mikroökonomie I/ Unternehmensführung*.
- Students with prior business or economics credits, can be admitted to basic & advanced bachelor courses.
- In order to apply for admission, complete the registration form in ILIAS or send your request with a recent transcript of records and a language certificate (B2 according to CEFR) to ausland@wiwi.

Admission to IUSP Courses (without tutorials!)

- Admission to the IUSP courses is restricted to students specialized in Accounting and Finance.
- In order to apply for admission complete the course registration form in ILIAS or send your request with a recent transcript of records to ausland@wiwi, before October 1st / April 1st.
