- ⇒ The topic form will be completed by the primary examiner and forwarded to the Examination Office.
- ⇒ The topic will only be issued after approval by the chair of the Examination Board.
- ⇒ The examiner is automatically appointed upon submission of the signature. The Examination Board reserves the right to review the examiner's eligibility to administer the examination.
- ⇒ At the end of the thesis, a signed affidavit must be enclosed (see sample at the end of the file).
- ⇒ Sample title page of a thesis
- ⇒ The thesis must be submitted to the Examination Office by the deadline, either in person or by mail (the **postmark** is the date that counts), in **two bound copies and a digital version** (to be submitted by email via the student account to the responsible clerk).
- ⇒ If your degree program requires an **oral final examination**, the examination must take place in the presence of the primary examiner and a competent assessor.
