B-VELPa-Seminar E: Migration and Human Development

Responsible: Prof. Dr. Martin Pinquart

- The seminar applies main topics in the field of developmental psychology to young people with migration background, focusing on the situation of Germany and other countries.
- In Germany, about 20% of the citizens have a migration background, meaning that they are foreigners, were born outside of Germany, or have at least one parent who has been born outside Germany. The percentage is higher in children and adolescents than in older age groups. In the first part of the seminar, we will discuss whether and how the psychological development of children with and without migration background differs, for example with regard to success in school, language development, social integration, and problem behavior. Factors will be identified that explain the observed differences. In the second part of the seminar, we will discuss interventions aimed at promoting a positive development of children and adolescents with migration background (e.g., in kindergarten, schools, families, or in the whole society). Amongst others, we will discuss whether mainstream programs for young people in general are as successful in children or adolescents with migration background and how specific interventions could be developed that focus on the risk factors and resources of children with migration background. The seminar will be held in English.

B-AOW1-Vorlesung: Social Psychology of Economic Processes

Responsible: Prof. Dr. Christopher Cohrs

- The lecture provides an overview of economic psychology and introduces selected topics based on key theories, empirical findings, and practical fields. The focus is on individual experiences and behavior at various points of contact between people and economic life (e.g., purchasing and consumption decisions, advertising, saving and investing, paying taxes), and on the social psychological dimensions of macroeconomic phenomena (e.g., globalization, sustainability, new technologies, economic growth, inequality).

B-VELPb-Seminar B: Anxiety

Responsible: Maria Willadsen

- In this seminar, we approach the phenomenon of anxiety from different perspectives: cognitive, learning theory, neurobiological and, at times, philosophical
- What distinguishes anxiety from fear or stress? When is anxiety adaptive, and when does it become pathological? How do anxieties arise – and how can they be unlearned? What role do trait and state anxiety, motivation and avoidance play?
- The seminar combines theoretical foundations with current research findings and invites participants to critically discuss central areas of tension in emotional psychology.

B-AOW1-Seminar A: Wealth and Well-Being

Responsible: Dr. Edward Clarke

- A prosperous, growing economy is often seen as a prerequisite for satisfying human needs and psychological well-being. Does economic growth really have this kind of effect on well-being? Are people in rich countries happier than people in poor countries? What role does the degree of economic inequality play in this? Does money make you happy? These and similar questions will be critically examined on the basis of theoretical and empirical work. The aim of the seminar is to provide a sound understanding of the interactions between the economy and well-being, along with its practical implications.

B-AOW1-Seminar B: Sustainable Consumer Behaviour

Responsible: Dr. Edward Clarke

- Climate change, environmental protection, sustainability... psychology has a lot to contribute to this topic. The way we deal with food, clothing, money and energy, for example, or more generally: the form of our economic activity has a decisive influence on how sustainably we live. As importantly, economic systems and structures also influence sustainable behaviour and can dictate to us what is possible. Therefore, economic psychology has important contributions to make to a transformation of society towards greater sustainability. This seminar will take a closer look at people in their role as consumers, investors, and citizens with regard to theoretical explanations, empirical findings and intervention approaches. Furthermore, we will discuss and debate broader conceptual problems such as the role of the individual in system-level environmental solutions.
- The following topics will be discussed, for example: Consumption (e.g. food, clothing, transportation); Energy transition (e.g. acceptance of renewable energies); Investment/Divestment; Citizen behaviour

B-KP2-Seminar A: Couple Relationships and Mental Health

Responsible: Anne Vogel

- Close social bonds, such as committed romantic relationships, have far-reaching implications for well-being and mental health, yet relationship distress and divorce are highly prevalent. Humans are fundamentally social beings, so how can we make sense of the challenges that lead once loving partners to making life miserable for each other? What are the clinical implications for the treatment of relationship difficulties and mental health problems?
- This seminar will focus on (a) basic research on intimate relationship functioning and its implications for wellbeing and mental health, and (b) applications to couple therapy and psychotherapy, primarily in the cognitive-behavioral tradition. We will discuss aspects of healthy relationship functioning as well as couple distress.

M-WPa/M-AOWb-Seminar: Diversity

Responsible: Tijana Karić Zorić

- One of the most pressing challenges for societies today is to handle diversity within and across their borders. For example, today about 20% of all individuals living in Germany have a migration background. In addition to the fact that migration is changing the composition of a society, it usually comes along with conflicts between societal members, such as stereotypes, prejudice and discrimination. This is part of our daily life. However, apart from diversity based on ethnic origin, a group of people can be diverse with respect to various characteristics like culture, religion, gender, age etc. Although diversity is often regarded as a challenge, it is also an opportunity allowing cultural exchange and broadening creative capacities. This seminar will examine the social psychological factors involved in the challenges and opportunities of diversity, with an applied focus on selected cases and contexts.

Last step:


We enter the grades and ECTS from your Belegliste into our database to enable the examination office to print the **Transcript of Record** and **sent it to you and your home university.**




