
# **Eating Out in Marburg**

Marburg is famous for its many little cafés and restaurants located in the city center.

Whether you would like to eat a sandwich or a pizza, sit down in a nice *Biergarten* or enjoy a meal in a restaurant – here are some recommendations for your lunch break or your evening out in Marburg.



# **Block** A

This block is located right across the university library and goes up the Ketzerbach featuring many of Marburg's favorites such as the Sudhaus.



## UB (University Library) (ger. "Universitätsbibliothek")

Not only is the library the main hub for a vast amount of Marburg's students to study, write, meet up, and generally fuel their interest, it is also where the second and third day of the conference will take place. The blue dots represent the main entrances to the library.

## M (Museum)

The museum is where the first meetup (June 9) will take place and where the welcome speeches will be held. As with the library, the blue dot represents the main entrance to the museum. The Restaurant Bottega is represented by the **orange dot** (north of Block M), there the Conference Dinner at the end of Day 2 (June 10) will take place.



## Block B

Climbing up the Oberstadt from the Elisabethkirche, one of Marburg's attractions, towards the city center while encountering a great variety of cafés and ice cream shops.


