Exposé for the application for acceptance of a dissertation

1. cover sheet

- Name of the doctoral candidate
- planned title of the dissertation
- supervising person(s)
- · place, date

2. problem statement

- introduction to the topic
- presentation of the problem and explanation of the relevance

3. objective

Explanation of the aim of the work and what is to be achieved at the end.

4. theoretical foundations

- Outline of the current state of research and clarification of basic definitions/concepts.
- Deficits in knowledge as a basis for the dissertation / Knowledge gaps in the state of the art of scientific debates (e.g. literature, empirical insights).

All supported by key literature references.

5. concept of the dissertation

- a) cumulative/non-cumulative?
- b) If cumulative, what publications are planned and how are they probably interrelated?
- c) External or at the Faculty of Geography?
- d) Based on a research project (name, sponsoring institution), or free topic?

Presentation of the hypothesis and the planned methodology.

6. time schedule

Specifies the different steps of the work until the deadline, if possible, with milestones that relate to the temporal availability of the PhD candidate.

7. bibliography

Overview of the sources used and thematically relevant literature in the form of a bibliography.
