Dear participants in the face-to-face courses of the Language Center,

please note the following organizational information regarding the face-to-face courses, as already sent by e-mail from the President's Office on 13.10.2021:

Access to the face-to-face courses of the Language Center is only possible with a valid 3-G-proof. This means: Before the start of your course, you must prove to your teacher that you have either been vaccinated (with a sufficient time gap) or have recovered, or that you have taken a test within the last 24 or 48 hours.

Please have this proof ready for your teacher to review prior to the start of the class.

Immunizations and Proof of Immunization:

Recognized vaccines are:

- Comirnaty (BionTech/Pfizer),
- Spikevax (Moderna),
- VaxZevria (AstraZeneca),
- Covid-19 Vaccine Janssen (Johnson & Johnson).

(If you have been vaccinated with a different vaccine, please see the note at the bottom).

The vaccination certificate of vaccination with a recognized vaccine can be obtained in pharmacies by EU citizens upon presentation of the vaccination certificate and a translation.

If you have been vaccinated with such a vaccine with a sufficient time interval, we ask you to have your vaccination certificates transferred to the CovPass app or the Corona warning app if possible. This will shorten the time it takes to check them prior to class.

If you have been vaccinated with an approved vaccine, but transfer to these apps is not possible, the UMR Legal Department will create a certificate that is valid only within the university. Please make an appointment to do so with Ms. Grgic, irina.grgic@verwaltung.uni-marburg.de.

Test evidence as an alternative to proof of vaccination or recovery.

If you do not have valid proof of vaccination or recovery, you may take a **free supervised antigen self-test** offered by Philipps Universität. These tests can only be used internally at the university and are valid for 24 hours. They are offered:

Monday through Friday between 07:40 and 09:30 a.m.

- Town Center: Old University Library, Wilhelm-Röpke-Str. 4, from 18 Oct. 2021.
- Lahnberge: Multipurpose disposition building, Hans-Meerwein-Str. 6, starting 10 Oct. 2021.

When scheduling your appointment, please allow for wait times prior to testing and bear in mind that it takes at least 15 minutes for a certificate to be issued after your test.

If you have been vaccinated with an unapproved vaccine, a full vaccination with an approved vaccine is possible and recommended. The new vaccination series can be started with a minimum interval of 28 days from the last vaccination (<https://www.rki.de/SharedDocs/FAQ/COVID-Impfen/gesamt.html>).

Many primary care physicians' offices offer vaccination appointments on short notice. Please ask your GP.
