

Criteria for Awarding Positions for the Advancement of Equal Opportunity

Bridging Positions

1. Fulfillment of formal criteria, including completion of doctorate (oral defense) by the start of funding; typically, no more than one year should have passed since the doctoral certificate was awarded (periods of maternity leave/parental leave/legal clerkship/a stay abroad, or the like can be taken into consideration);
2. Evidence of exceptional academic quality;
3. Good to excellent academic achievements in previous studies and exams;
4. Conclusive evidence that the project proposal to a research funding institution can be submitted within a period of one year; proof that the candidate will be able to devote her full work capacity to preparing her own research agenda in accordance with the purpose of the bridging funding, particularly if the dissertation has not yet been published;
5. Involvement in current research and teaching at Philipps-Universität Marburg; candidates confirm at the time of application their binding intent to pursue the research project for which the proposal is being prepared at Philipps-Universität Marburg; this intent must be confirmed by the reviewer;
6. Evaluation of the candidate and the research project in the review. The information in the application must match the information in the review;
7. Publications: Complete list of publications (please mark the publications, which are relevant for your project. Submitted and accepted (quotable) publications can be listed too, with a suitable note. Publications in process or preparation can't be accepted.);
8. Less important: social criteria (children, severe disability, chronic illness, special needs); given equal qualifications, preferential consideration of individuals with disabilities in accordance with § 2, para. 2 and 3 SGB IX.
