• <u>Type:</u> Extracurricular training to develop skills in these areas:


- Research practice

- <u>Costs:</u> Internal (members): free half-day courses; 25 EUR/d; external: 75 EUR/d; defrayal of costs for childcare

- <u>Target grp.:</u> Doctoral candidates HSS/LNS

2.3 Program for Doctoral Candidates: Getting Started for Foreigners



• <u>Type:</u> Workshops for foreign doctoral candidates in German and English in cooperation with the International Office (Dep. VI),

1–2 German courses /semester (Language Center)

- <u>Target grp.</u>: Doctoral candidates and postdocs from abroad
- Notes: Minimum number of 5 participants;
 beginner-level language courses
- <u>Costs:</u> Free of charge (DAAD financial assistance via STIBET)
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Christine Berger (Postdoctoral Program), MARA, Dr. Karin Awe (Program for Doctoral Candidates), Language Center, Dr. Susanne Duxa

3.1 Doctoral Scholarships



- <u>Type/no.:</u> Two full scholarships annually, alternating between humanities & social sciences, and life & natural sciences
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Junior scholars with especially high qualifications who want to pursue their dissertation at Marburg Univ.
- <u>Amounts:</u> 1,300 EUR + 103 EUR materials allowance, 400 EUR child allow. (1 child, add'l children 100 EUR each)
- <u>Duration:</u> 3 years total, as a rule initially for 2 years
- <u>Source:</u> University funding (via MARA), DFG guidelines
- <u>Requirem.</u>: Studies completed, advisor, performance criteria
- <u>Timing:</u> Call for applications in July; funding commences in Jan.
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



3.2 Travel Assistance

MARA Ware University

• <u>Art:</u>

- Travel assistance (travel expenses/overnight stays/misc. costs; no meal expenses/literature/travel to Germany) for International travel:
 - Travel to conferences (only for contributors)
 - Travel for academic collaboration (also summer schools)
 - Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)

Domestic travel:

- Travel to national conferences (as a rule only if applicant is presenting)
- Travel to international conferences (only if applicant is contributing)
- Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)
- <u>Target grp.:</u> Doctoral candidate members of MARA, postdocs
- Amounts: Per actual costs, up to 2,000 EUR, 1,500 EUR/trip
- <u>Duration:</u> Generally for the length of the trip
- Source: MARA funding, according to MARA provisions
- <u>Requirem.</u>: For diss./research, up to 2 x (1 x each)
- <u>Timing:</u> Call for applications January & June for current year
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



3.3 Conference Funding



- <u>Type:</u> For organizing conferences (conferencerelated costs, except for meal expenses, publishing costs, and fees for speakers from Marburg University)
- <u>Target grp.:</u> MARA members, MARA academic groups
- <u>Amount:</u> Up to 1,000 EUR + 250 EUR childcare, per actual costs and available funds
- <u>Duration:</u> For the length of the conference
- <u>Source:</u> MARA funding, according to MARA provisions
- <u>Requirem.</u>: For the purpose of funding Marburg doctoral candidates, public events, members of MARA
- <u>Timing:</u> Applications all year, at least 4 months prior to conference
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



3.4 Equal Opportunity



- <u>Type:</u> Full scholarships for completion of dissertation projects (doc. candidates) and habilitations (postdocs)
 - Bridging positions to develop a proposal for third-party funding (postdocs)
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Outstanding female junior scholars
- <u>Amount:</u> Schol.: doc. candidates 1,300 EUR (med. 670 EUR), postdocs 1,750 EUR + 103 EUR mat. + child allow.; pos.: E13/2
- <u>Duration:</u> Completion schol. 3–6 months, bridging pos. 12 months
- <u>Source:</u> Funding by Female Prof. Progr., acc. to MARA/DFG prov.
- <u>Requirem.:</u> Exceptional acad. quality, involvement in UMR, completion, beginning in the current year, PhD compl. scholarships: MARA members, bridging pos.: PhD completed ≤ 1 yr.
- <u>Timing:</u> Call for applications in spring
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



3.5 Funding by University Foundations

- <u>Type:</u> Publishing costs for dissertations, etc. (univ. foundation also support for academic events, 25 % of which for catering, and for postdocs up to age 35; CCSS also travel expenses, literature, photocopying costs at archives)
- <u>Target grp.</u>: UMR membership (univ. found./CCSS: time since leaving < 1 yr) (WHES humanities/CCSS HSS, human geography)

• <u>Amount:</u> Varies

- <u>Source:</u> Funding by Universitätsstiftung Marburg/Wilhelm-Hahnund-Erben-Stiftung/Carl und Charlotte Schott Stiftung
 <u>Requirem.:</u> Only supplemental funding (univ. foundation/CCSS diss. at least excellent)
- <u>Timing:</u> Once per year, generally spring
- <u>Resp.:</u> Dep. V Budget and Materials, Regina Kappel

- Application for Third-Party Funding: <u>Certificate Program EMF</u> (start is possible during doctoral studies)

- Individual Coaching



4.1 Communicating Academic Content



- <u>Type:</u> Acquisition of skills to communicate research topics beyond expert communities: workshops, summer and winter schools, individual coaching
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Advanced doctoral candidates, postdocs
- <u>Notes:</u> Content, requirements for attending, dates, modalities, costs see 'Course announcements' (website)
- <u>Costs:</u> Workshops: internal (members): 25 EUR/day; external: 75 EUR/day; individual coaching/free
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Christine Berger (Postdoctoral Program)



4.2 Designing and Managing Research Projects (EMF)



- <u>Type:</u> Certifying program for the acquisition of skills in the areas of project development, application, and management of third-party funding; subject areas:
 - CC Cross-Category Courses and Activities
 - PD Project Design and Application
 - PM Project Management
 - PR Presentation of Research Projects
 - TR Transfer

Joint project with Universität Kassel

- <u>Target grp.:</u> Doctoral candidates & postdocs (application for postdoc phase)
- <u>Requirem.</u>: Mandatory/elective courses,

peer assessment of project application

- <u>Costs:</u> Internal: 200 EUR, external: 500 EUR;
 - Workshops MR: internal: 25 EUR/d; external: 75 EUR/d
 - Resp.: MARA, Dr. Christine Berger (Postdoctoral Program)

5.1 Individual Consultation



• <u>Type:</u>

Personal one-on-one consultation on various subjects:

- Doctorate, yes or no?
- Financing your doctorate/postdoc phase
- MARA funding
- Career paths
- Skill acquisition
- Challenges and conflicts
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Doctoral candidates and postdocs
- <u>Costs:</u> Free of charge
- <u>Timing:</u> Appointment by arrangement
- <u>Resp.:</u> Depending on the topic, MARA employees or referral to a contact person within UMR
 - Doctoral candidates (HSS): Dr. Ines Braune
 - Doctoral candidates (LNS): Dr. Karin Awe
 - Postdocs: Dr. Christine Berger, Dr. Ines Braune
 - MARA-funding: Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



5.2 Individual Writing Consultation



- <u>Type:</u> Individual consultation by writing consultants
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Doctoral candidates
- <u>Costs:</u> free of charge
- <u>Duration:</u> 45–90 minutes per consultation session, up to 5 appointments
- <u>Requirem.:</u> Registration with the writing consultant, MARA membership
- <u>Timing:</u> Appointment by arrangement
- <u>Resp.:</u> Dr. Christine Noeres-Mühl (writing consultant German),
 - Dr. Fabienne Quennet (writing consultant English)



5.3 Coaching



- <u>Type:</u> Personal one-on-one consultation, ideally in combination with attending a MARA workshop, particularly on career planning, assessment of applications for third-party funding, communication of academic content, and presentations and conference communication.
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Advanced doctoral students, postdocs
- <u>Costs:</u> free of charge
- Duration: Up to 5 consultations of 90 minutes each
- <u>Requirem.:</u> MARA membership
- <u>Timing:</u> Informal application at any time
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Christine Berger (Postdoctoral Program)



5.4 Peer Consultation



- <u>Type:</u> Introduction of a group of doctoral candidates and postdocs to cooperative consultation
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Advanced doctoral candidates, postdocs
- <u>Costs:</u> Payment of costs for the coach for three appointments
- <u>Source:</u> MARA funding
- <u>Requirem.:</u> MARA membership
- <u>Timing:</u> Informal application at any time
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Christine Berger (Postdoctoral Program)



5.5 Mentoring



- Mentoring programs with the University of Giessen for postdocs, <u>https://www.uni-marburg.de/en/mara/consultation-services/pcmo-</u> <u>mentoring</u>
- Mentoring Hessen: https://www.mentoringhessen.de/
 - ProCareer.MINT: addresses female students of the MINT subjects
 - ProCarreer.DOC: for female doctoral candidates and postdocs of all disciplines at an early stage
 - ProAcademia: supports female postdocs who have already decided to go into science
 - ProProfessur: specific support for female postdocs on the path to a professorship



5.6 MARA Academic Groups



<u>Type:</u> Self-organized interdisciplinary working groups under the umbrella of MARA

- <u>Goal:</u> Research-specific networking, support, courses and events, conferences, etc.
- <u>Target grp.</u>: Doctoral candidates, postdocs
- <u>Requirem.</u>: Majority and leadership must be MARA members
- <u>Notes:</u> Opportunity to present group on MARA website, meeting space, distribution of information
- <u>Timing:</u> Informal application at any time
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Ines Braune (Managing Director)





5.7 Mara Day/Scientists' Day

- <u>Type:</u> Information and networking day for junior scholars
- <u>Target grp.:</u> Doctoral candidates, postdocs, professors of Philipps-Universität Marburg, non-members
- <u>Notes:</u>
 Free participation
- <u>Resp.:</u> MARA, Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder, MARA, Dr. Ines Braune
