1.1 MARA Membership




- **Doctoral candidates**: Regardless of whether you are doing your doctorate with a scholarship, on a state or third-party-funded position, or part-time at Philipps-Universität Marburg, you are entitled to a membership at MARA.
- ➤ Required is the registration as a doctoral candidate in MARVIN and the approval of your self-registration by your department.
- **Postdocs**: If you are doing postdoctoral research at Philipps-Universität Marburg, then you are automatically a member of MARA.
- ➤ You count as a postdoc if you already hold your doctoral degree and have an employment contract at Philipps-Universität Marburg.

3.1 Doctoral Scholarships



Type/no.: Two full scholarships annually, alternating between

humanities & social sciences, and life & natural

sciences

Target grp.: Junior scholars with especially high qualifications

who want to pursue their dissertation at Marburg Univ.

Amounts: 1,300 EUR + 103 EUR materials allowance,

400 EUR child allow. (1 child, additional children 100

EUR each)

<u>Duration:</u> 3 years total, as a rule initially for 2 years

Requirem.: Enrollment at a department of Philipps-Universität

Marburg, performance criteria

<u>Timing:</u> Call for applications in July; funding commences in

January



3.2 Travel Assistance



Type: Travel assistance (travel expenses/overnight stays/misc. costs; no meal expenses/literature/travel to Germany)

International travel:

- Travel to conferences (only for contributors)
- Travel for academic collaboration with scientists
- Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)

Domestic travel:

- Travel to national conferences (usually only if applicant is presenting)
- Travel to international conferences (only if applicant is contributing)
- Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)
- Target grp.: Doctoral candidate members of MARA, postdocs
- Amount: Per actual costs, up to 2,000 EUR, 1,500 EUR/trip
- Requirem.: For diss./research relevant travel
- <u>Timing:</u> Call for applications usually twice a year



3.3 Conference Funding



• <u>Type:</u> For organizing conferences (conference-

related costs, except for meal expenses, publishing

costs, and fees for speakers from Marburg University)

Target grp.: Doctoral candidates and postdocs at Philipps-

Universität Marburg

Amount: Up to 1,000 EUR + 250 EUR childcare,

per actual costs and available funds

<u>Duration:</u> For the length of the conference

Requirem.: For the purpose of funding Marburg doctoral

candidates, public events

<u>Timing:</u> Applications all year, at least 3 months prior to

conference



3.4 Equal Opportunity



• Type: Full scholarships for completion of dissertation projects (doctoral

candidates) and habilitations (postdocs)

Bridging positions to develop a proposal for third-party funding

(postdocs)

Target grp.: Outstanding female junior scholars

Amount: Doc. cand. = 1,300 EUR (med. 670 EUR) + child allow,

Postdocs = 1,750 EUR + 103 EUR mat. + child allow,

Bridg. pos.: = E13/50%

<u>Duration:</u> Completion schol. max. 6 months, bridging pos. 12 months

Requirem.: Exceptional acad. quality, involvement in UMR, beginning

in the current year

Bridging pos.: PhD completed ≤ 1 yr.

<u>Timing:</u> Call for applications once every year in spring

4.1 Individual Consultation



- Personal one-on-one consultation on various subjects:
 - Doctorate, yes or no?
 - Financing your doctorate/postdoc phase
 - MARA funding
 - Career paths
 - Skill acquisition
 - Challenges and conflicts
- Depending on the topic, MARA employees or referral to a contact person within UMR
 - Doctoral candidates (HSS): Dr. Ines Braune
 - Doctoral candidates (LNS): Dr. Karin Awe
 - Postdocs: Dr. Christine Berger, Dr. Ines Braune
 - MARA-funding: Dr. Jan-Paul Klünder



4.2 Coaching



- Personal one-on-one consultation, ideally in combination with attending a MARA workshop, particularly on
 - career planning,
 - assessment of applications for third-party funding
 - communication of academic content
 - presentations and conference communication.
- Target group: Advanced doctoral candidates, postdocs
- MARA covers the costs for coaching (up to five consultations of 90 minutes each)
