



Travel Assistance for Doctoral Candidates and Postdocs



- Travel expenses/overnight stays/misc. costs
- No meal expenses/literature/travel to Germany
- For dissertation/research relevant travel

International travel

Travel to conferences (only for contributors)

Travel for academic collaboration with scientists

Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)

Domestic travel

Travel to national conferences (only if applicant is presenting)

Travel to international conferences (only if applicant is contributing)

Field research (archive, library, monuments, etc.)

- > Amount: Per actual costs, up to 2,000 EUR, 1,500 EUR/trip
- > **Timing:** Call for applications usually twice a year







- > For organizing conferences (conference-related costs)
- No meal costs, printing costs for publications and internal fees
- ➤ Up to **1,500 EUR** + 250 EUR childcare, per actual costs and available funds
- Requirements: For the purpose of funding Marburg doctoral candidates and postdocs, public events
- > Applications all year, at least 3 months prior to conference







- Annually for all disciplines
- For particularly qualified academics who are completing their dissertations at the Philipps University of Marburg
- ➤ EUR 1,650 + EUR 100 material allowance, EUR 400 child allowance (1st child, additional children EUR 100 each)
- > For max. 6 months
- Requirement: completion within the funding period, enrollment at a department at Philipps University and performance criteria







- Full scholarships for completion of habilitations (postdocs) for 6 months
- Outstanding female junior scholars

Postdocs = 1,750 EUR + 103 EUR mat. + child allow.

- Requirements: Exceptional acad. quality, involvement in UMR, beginning in the current year
- Applications possible all year round from 2025







- Philipps University doctoral and postdoctoral students with family responsibilities are eligible to apply to finance a student assistant.
- ➤ The support of a student assistant is funded at 20 hours per month for a maximum term of 6 months.
- Requirements: doctoral candidates and postdocs with time-limited employment contracts and no own personnel funds + family obligations.
- > Application deadline expected to be late November 2025

Legal Issues



Doctoral candidates Regardless of whether you are doing your doctorate with a scholarship, on a state or third-party-funded position, or part-time at Philipps-Universität Marburg, you are entitled to take advantage of the MARA services.

➤ Required is the registration as a doctoral candidate in <u>MARVIN</u> and the approval of your self-registration by your department.

Postdocs If you are doing postdoctoral research at Philipps-Universität Marburg, then you are automatically a member of MARA.

You count as a postdoc if you finished your disputation and have an employment contract at Philipps-Universität Marburg.










<u>Creative Space – Part of the XSpaces-initiative</u>

The XSpaces are innovative, creative and interconnected workspaces. They support new forms of academic collaboration.



Makerspace:

The Makerspace is used for teaching and research as well as for start-up promotion. Working with 3-D data and printing is possible, as well as practical work with tools to create prototypes.

Game Lab:

The Game Lab offers game consoles (PS5, XboX, Switch) and powerful workstations (Blender, Unity, etc.) as well as a VR area (HTC Vive, Pico Neo 3), augmented reality headsets and a stationary VR treadmill to view computer and video games, virtual reality apps and serious games and evaluate them for use in research and teaching.

Open Lab:

In the Open Lab, there is a 3D scanner and 3D printer to make 3D scans of real or illustrative objects, model figures or technical prototypes. Opportunities for collaborative digital work are also offered with the help of an interactive touch display.

What is project Creative Space about?

Space

- Establishment of a creative center, especially for young scientists
- Attractive rooms with flexible furnishings as well as technical and analogue infrastructure for creative collaboration
- Interdisciplinary meeting place and project exchange

Funding

- Allocation of funding to doctoral candidates and postdocs for interdisciplinary initiatives and for invitations to visiting scholars
- Up to 5000 € / application for the implementation of innovative ideas in the fields of science, science policy, science communication or transfer

Conceptual support

- Design Thinking
- · Creative project development
- Conceptual advice on event formats
- Support by moderation of events

Goals:

- Strengthening the early independence and the individual academic profile of early stage researchers
- Promotion of interdisciplinary cooperation and networking
- Supporting the successful development of projects and applications as well as the organisation of events




A place for brainstorming. A space for network meetings, dialogue and project development. A place to get something off the ground together. An event space.









Setting 1: Workshop / Meeting (20 Pers.)

Equipment:

<u>Creative Space – Funding for (interdisciplinary)</u> <u>initiatives and for invitations of guest researchers</u>

Through the Creative Space project, **phd candidates and postdocs** of Philipps-Universität Marburg can apply for funding for

- a) (interdisciplinary) initiatives
- b) invitations of guest researchers (Postdocs)

Each application can be funded with a maximum of 5000 €.

Who can apply?

Applications must be submitted by phd candidates and/or postdocs. For the application, at least three applicants are required. In order to promote interdisciplinarity, several departments should be involved. In order to ensure the funding of innovative initiatives, the topic must be new for the selected constellation of participants.
