Career Fair "Work in the Future – Inspiration from Science and Practice": Contest for the Most Convincing Elevator Pitch

The labor market is in flux. Trends such as increasing digitization (e.g., Big Data, Industry 4.0), the diversification of types of employment, or rapid change in professions are making new demands on the future workforce as well as on businesses and education.

On **Thursday, November 8, 2018**, together with the Career Center, the Junior Scholars Office, and the International Office, MARA will be organizing a **career fair**. Students and junior scholars will have the opportunity to meet with employers and labor market experts as part of a program tailored to specific target groups. - Present the purpose of your research in a nutshell and spark curiosity!
- Our offer includes the opportunity to participate in professional coaching (on Oct 23 and 31, 14:00–17:00, respectively).

You may give your talk in German or English. The choice of format is up to you (PowerPoint, another (audio-) visual medium, or no medium at all).

What's in it for you?

- Participation in professional coaching free of charge.
- Attention from other researchers and scholars as well as employers for your research.
- Practice in presenting the purpose of your research in a nutshell. This increases your chances in a job interview with a potential employer!
- The winner will receive a voucher worth 100 EUR toward MARA continuing education offerings.
