

Exemption from the requirement to provide proof of English language proficiency

Applicants are generally exempt from the requirement to provide proof of English language proficiency if they submit the following certificates:

Secondary school diplomas from:

- Australia
- Canada (all provinces except Quebec and New Brunswick)
- USA (high school diploma)

as well as

- British A-level certificates
- Irish Leaving Certificate
- New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement
- Scottish Qualifications Certificate

Provided that the studies were completed in the respective country:

University degrees from

- Australia
- Great Britain
- Ireland
- Canada (except degrees from the provinces of Quebec and New Brunswick)
- New Zealand
- USA

The above educational qualifications are considered proof of native language proficiency and are not assigned to a specific level.
