## **Definition of terms**

- <u>Course list</u> → The list of courses you are taking. It is only for internal use by Philipps-Universität Marburg, i.e., it is NOT the official document (Transcript of Records) that your university and you will receive at the end of your stay. However, the Course list is a prerequisite to create the Transcript of Records!
  - You will have to create your Course list in Mobility Online at the start of every semester. The document "Course list Step-by-step instructions" will explain exactly how this works.
- <u>Erasmus Departmental Coordinator</u> → The people working in the various departments at Philipps-Universität Marburg who are responsible for questions about courses. You can find a complete overview of all departmental coordinators here:
